Main Activities

- To update the veterinarians regarding news of skills & development in the field of veterinary science, a news letter named “News Link” were published in July-13 & Jan-14. About 3000 copies were circulated to all our members, Vet. Colleges other state councils, VCI & other related institutions.

- The Gujarat Veterinary Council has financially supported to organise 4 seminars. one of that is organised by Frozen semen station, Patan on 18-04-13 on Effect of climate change on Animal Production.(2) one seminar was organised at Sumul Dairy, Surat on Advance Technology on Dairy Farming “dated on 05-05-2013. approximately 200-225 were participated in the seminar.
- Anand Veterinary college, Anand Celebrating its Golden Jubilee Year. The Gujarat Veterinary Council has given Rs.5,00,000/- as platinum Sponsorship. In this connection Anand Veterinary college organised seminar on “Veterinary Education-Challenges and future Scenario “dated on 04-01-2014.
